8. Qualifying times

All Open events carry a qualifying time. All other events require no previous achievement.

9. **Age**

Age for both weekends is as at 20 March 2021

10. Eligibility

Swimmers must qualify under the GSI bylaws governing eligibility – both residentlial/registration and competion.

11. Entries

Entries are to be completed via SwimCentral Attendees are monitored to ensure all qualifications are met. Entries for Individual events (March 20/21) close on March 16. Entries for relays (May 1) close on April 26.

12. Relay entries and 50m Freestyle

Relay TM file is on the GSI website. As this meet stands alone, relay names must be submitted with TM files. 50m Free relays will be online with Swim Central

13. **Opening ceremony** will be brief due to COVID safe requirements and the different meet format (no finlals) The Athlete's Oath will be read by 2020 Men's and Women's champions: Jordyn and Molly Cargill and the Official's Oath will be read by GSI Vice President and GSI Official, Michelle Harris.

14. Marshalling

GSI will be using Assisted Self Marshalling for this competition. Athletes will be instructed by the check starter to move behind the blocks once the event ahead of them has entered the water. An overflow area (marshalling tent) will be available for swimmers to ready themselves prior to their race. When Self Marshalling is in place, there is no requirement for the swimmers to use this area, they may just turn up behind the blocks without any formal check in.

15. Medal Presentation

Medals will be available for collection near the Announcer's table. No formal presentation will take place, but the winner's dais will be available for photography purposes.

16. **COVID** requirements

QR code must be scanned upon entry to the centre. GSI will work closely with the Warragul Swimming Club and the YMCA on the requirements that are expected to provide a COVIDSafe event to our athletes, Technical Officials, Coaches, staff, spectators, and wider swimming community.

By attending this competition, you agree to follow the Victorian Governments' restrictions and guidelines relating to COVID-19 and meet COVID-19 Terms & Conditions | Entry & Attendance at Competitions. Any updates to the conduct of these events will be communicated through the GSI website and social media channels.
